Father Involvement

Missouri:

The percentage of single-parent families rose from 23% in 1990 to 28% in 2000.

Missouri:

In 2001, 34.8% of births in Missouri were to unmarried women.

In 2000, the rate of births to teens was 27 per 1,000.

Johnson County:

The percentage of births to unmarried mothers was 29.41% in 2001.

In 2001, the rate of births to teens (under 18) was 5.29%.

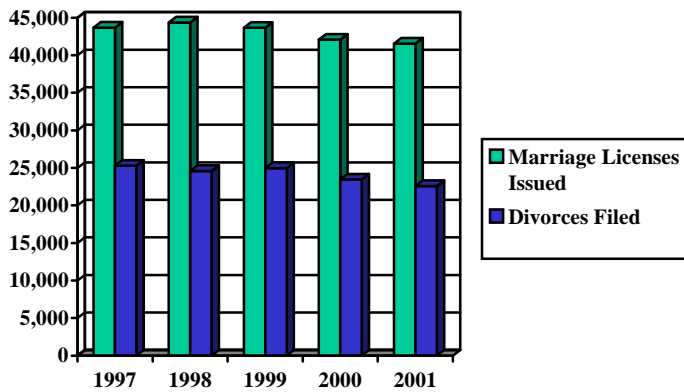

Nationally, “spouses who said they were quite unhappy with their marriage *who stayed married* were much happier five years later”.

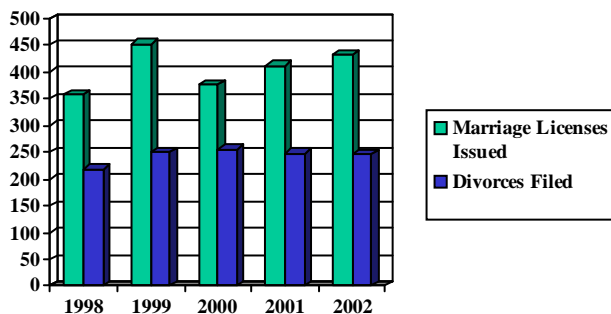
